

Student Support Teams (SST)

Student Support Team (SST)

SST or Student Support Team is a group of school staff and Administrators who work together to identify students who are facing challenges academically, behaviorally, socially and emotionally. This team is responsible for providing resources and outreach to students and families to ensure student success.

Staff Resources

- School Counselor
- School Psychologist
- Pupil Personnel Worker
- Community Superintendent & Director of Schools

School Counselor

Support all students academically, socially, and emotionally. Provides small group counseling to students in a variety of areas including divorce, making friends, and mental well-being. Help students with developing plans/pathways to completion of high school and post high school graduation including career planning and college applications.

School Psychologist

Provides services according to the individual needs of a student. Provides individual and group counseling for students with an individualized education plan. Help school staff understand learning and behavior problems and their effects on student achievement. Participate on school problem solving teams.

Pupil Personnel Worker

Works collaboratively with school staff, students, parents, and community agencies. Provides intervention and support for students with chronic attendance problems, assist families with enrollment, residency, and placement issues.

Community Superintendent & Director of Schools

Provides supervision and support to elementary, middle, and high school administrators in a variety of ways including school improvement and professional learning. Assists families with unresolved school matters that were addressed by the school principal.

The Importance

- Teachers have the opportunity to...
 - Share academic progress and growth
 - Share testing data/assessments
 - Share classroom observations (strengths of child, learning behaviors, areas to improve upon)
 - Provide an overview of upcoming standards/topics covered and what you can do to support your child at home (resources)
- Parents/Guardians have the opportunity to...
 - Gain valuable information about their child's academic, social and behavioral progress, strengths and improvements needed
 - Ask questions and open communication with teacher
 - Put a name to a face // makes discussions at home more personable



Scheduling

- The conference sign up window opens at 8am on Monday, November 6
- The sign up window closes at 4pm on Thursday November 16
- Parents sign up through <u>HCPSS Connect</u>
 <u>Synergy</u> with own login credentials

Click on the Conference tab in the left navigation panel, and click Parent Conferences. Select the conference time you want for each class listed. Check with your school for the date when you can start scheduling conferences.

What You Should Know:

BEFORE the Conference

- 1. Talk with your child
 - Communicates value of education and school partnership
 - Helps you to know what to share and what to ask
- 2. Develop a list of items that you want to share
 - Communicate any challenges or areas of interest
 - The more teachers know about your child, the better they can reach and teach your child in the classroom
- 3. Develop a list of questions
 - What are ways that I can further support, strengthen, improve my

What You Should Know:

DURING the Conference

- 1. Take Notes to remember key points
- Ask most important questions first time goes by very quickly
- If anything is unclear, ask clarifying questions
- Reach agreement on any action steps or student, teacher or parent

What You Should Know:

AFTER the Conference

- Talk with your child about any key takeaways/outcomes from the conference
- 2. Follow up on action items developed during the conference
- 3. Maintain communication with teacher
- 4. Check in with your child daily, every couple of days to monitor their work completion and work habits

Important Note

Parents have the right to request a teacher conference any other time during the school year within staff work hours with the exception of one week before and after

conference week.



Tap a course to view more information or tap the student name at the top to change the view to a different child.





Course (Subject) View


Here we see the child's language arts course.

Tap on an assignment to see more details (next slide).











Select the calendar icon at the bottom of the app to view events, and assignments for all subjects by day.
